Tēnā koe Ms McIntyre

I refer to your email of 11 April 2019, requesting information about searches in prisons. Your request was considered under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA) and responded to on 10 May 2019 (our reference C107063).

On 17 January 2020, Corrections was advised by the Office of the Ombudsman of a complaint relating to our response to your request. Upon reviewing your request, Corrections has reconsidered our response.

As we advised in our letter dated 18 February 2020, we have carried out another search of our records, and on this occasion have been able to identify some of the information you requested.

The safety and security of prisoners and staff is paramount. We place considerable emphasis on preventing contraband from entering prisons, apprehending those who attempt to smuggle it in, and eliminating opportunities for organised crime. These measures all contribute toward our bottom line of improving public safety, and our ultimate goal of reducing re-offending.

Contraband in prisons includes alcohol, communication devices, drugs, drug paraphernalia, tattoo equipment, weapons and other items. Items that are prohibited may include everyday and seemingly innocent items that, while not illegal, may be used inappropriately by prisoners.

Our efforts are keeping drugs and other contraband out of the hands of prisoners. There were 6,185 contraband finds in 2018/19, including 1,323 drug contraband and paraphernalia finds. Additionally, less than four percent of general random drug tests undertaken in prison returned a positive result, compared to 2010/11 when the rate was 6.8 percent. More information on contraband finds is available in Corrections' Annual Report, available on our website at: www.corrections.govt.nz/resources/strategic_reports/annual-reports/annual_report_201819.

When determining the appropriate type of search to detect an unauthorised item, staff are required to use the least intrusive search method that will be sufficient to retrieve the unauthorised item in each particular situation. Searches can be carried out by way of metal detector, x-ray machine, drug detection dog, rub-down search, or strip search.

There are generally three occasions where staff can consider strip searching a prisoner. Each occasion has different legislative standards under the Corrections Act 2004 (the Act) that must be met before a prisoner is searched. These occasions are:

- Event based – mandatory (section 98(7) of the Act);
- Event based – specified (section 98(6) of the Act); or
- Reasonable grounds (section 98(3) of the Act).

Mandatory strip searches must be carried out when a prisoner is first admitted to a prison, when the prisoner is received in a prison on transfer from another prison, or returns to a prison for outside employment, court appearances, medical appointments, when initially segregated because of risk of self-harm and upon any return to the segregated area from any area frequented by other prisoners, or any other reason in accordance with the Act.

Specified strip searches may be carried out in a number of circumstances, particularly those related to prisoner movements, including (but not limited to) before or after visits, or when a prisoner is brought before a Visiting Justice or a hearing adjudicator.

Reasonable grounds strip searches may be carried out if an officer has reasonable grounds for believing that a prisoner has in his or her possession an unauthorised item, approval has been obtained from the relevant manager for the conduct of a strip search, and a strip search is necessary in the circumstances for the purpose of detecting an unauthorised item.

You requested the following information:

Please provide me with the following information, from as far back as records permit until the current date. Please provide this information for each prison, broken down by both fiscal year and purpose of the search (e.g. Section 98(7) of the Corrections Act 2004):

1) *The total number of searches carried out on prisoners*

Please find attached as Appendix One the requested information from the implementation of the Act in 2004 to 2019. Please note that there are some limitations to this data. Firstly, mandatory strip searches carried out under section 98(7) of the Act are not consistently recorded, unless contraband is found. This is due to the volume of such searches that Corrections is statutorily obligated to carry out; furthermore, any absences from the prison or transfers will be recorded on a prisoner's file, which necessarily indicates that a strip search will have taken place.

Scanner and rub-down searches are also not consistently recorded, also due to the volume of these that are conducted. For example, rub-down searches are required to be conducted any time a prisoner moves between areas. These numbers have been provided in the response since 2018 when this reporting function was first introduced. However, we would urge caution when considering these figures, as they are by no means a complete representation of the numbers of these types of searches that are carried out, and the numbers vary significantly from prison to prison depending on the approach to reporting these at each site.

Secondly, as referenced above, the function within Corrections' prisoner database where prisoner searches are recorded was updated in 2018. More options were provided for prisoner strip searches, with specific sections of the Act identified under which strip searches could be carried out. The purpose of this was to simplify and clarify reporting on strip searches. However, this means that data on searches prior to 2018 may be less reliable than more recent data, and is not necessarily comparable with the more recent data. The search reasons labelled 'VOID' in the attached response are the search categories that staff were able to select prior to 2018.

You may wish to note that, because our reporting tools around prisoner searches have changed in the intervening years, we have also been unable to replicate the figures provided in the earlier OIA response referred to in your complaint to the Ombudsman (C76659).

Please also note that search information is recorded by calendar year, rather than fiscal year as requested.

2) The total number of searches carried out on cells


This part of your request was previously declined under section 18(f) of the OIA, as we considered that we could not provide the requested information without substantial collation and research. Following further consultation with custodial Corrections staff, I am advised that Corrections conducts random searches of all cells on a regular basis, with the aim of searching each cell at least once every month. Monthly records of these searches are made by staff in each individual unit at each prison, but this information is not collated centrally.

Records of non-routine cell searches (for example, where there is reasonable cause for staff to believe that a cell may contain contraband) are also not maintained centrally. Such information is held on individual incident reports. Furthermore, in the case of double bunked cells, incidents of cell searches or contraband finds within cells are usually attributed to both prisoners residing in a double bunked cell, making it still more difficult to accurately identify the numbers of cell searches that are carried out.

Accordingly, we maintain our original decision to decline this part of your request pursuant to section 18(f) of the OIA, as the requested information cannot be made available without substantial collation or research.
