Dear Mr Davenport

I refer to your Official Information Act request of 3 July 2019 for information relating to written traffic warnings.

You requested:

1. *Thanks for that [IR-01-19-12638]. To help making another request for this, can you please let me know what information is recorded for WTW's? I had assumed that the registered owner of a vehicle would be, but it appears not.*

Please refer to table one (below) for the list of fields that can be filled out by an officer when completing a written traffic warning. Please note the issuing of a Written Traffic Warning requires an admission of guilt on the driver's part. WTWs are issued to the driver of the vehicle at the time, who may or may not be the registered owner of the vehicle. No reference to the registered owner of the vehicle is required. Additionally, while vehicle type is a listed field in a WTW, it is selected from a predetermined list of vehicle types and no further differentiation between a privately used or commercially used vehicle is required.


