Request made under the Official Information Act 1982

You requested information on 25 July 2013 from the New Zealand Police on prosecutions for accidents involving pedestrians. As advised on 29 July 2013, your questions (a) and (b) were transferred to the NZ Transport Agency to respond to.

Your questions and our responses are provided below. Our crash data classifies skateboarders and wheeled pedestrians as 'pedestrians', so these are included in the figures below.

(a) In each of the last five calendar years (2008 to 2012) how many pedestrians were killed in road accidents?

(b) In each of the last five calendar years (2008 to 2012) how many pedestrians were seriously injured in road accidents?
