Dear Ti Lamusse

On 16 May 2019, you emailed the Ministry requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982, the following information:

- 1. The total number of welfare recipients per annum, as far back as records permit. Please break this down by the type of benefit, e.g. superannuation, JSS, accommodation supplement. I understand that some benefits have been renamed or no longer exist, please provide data for those benefits as well, as far back as records permit.*
- 2. Please break down the benefit type by ethnicity and gender, e.g. the total number of people on super, who are Pākehā and female, Pākehā and male*

The Ministry works with people to ensure they are receiving their full and correct entitlement. There is a range of support available to people depending on their circumstances.

A number of factors are considered when a person's eligibility for assistance is being assessed. The online eligibility guide, launched in July 2018, helps individuals identify the types of financial assistance they may qualify for. This guidance can be found at the following Work and Income website: www.workandincome.govt.nz/online-services/eligibility/index.html.

You may be aware that from 15 July 2013, New Zealand's welfare system changed to better help people prepare for employment. The focus is on what people can do to achieve a better future for themselves and their families. Three benefits replaced most of the previous benefit types, including the types you requested information for. These are:

- **Jobseeker Support** – Replaced the Unemployment Benefit, Sickness Benefit, Domestic Purposes Benefit (Women Alone, Sole Parent if youngest child is aged 14 and over) and the Widow's Benefit (without children, or if youngest child is aged 14 and over). Jobseeker Support is available to people who are able to usually work full-time. It also includes people who can only work part-time or are unable to currently look for work, for example those who have a health condition, injury or disability.
- **Sole Parent Support** – Replaced the Domestic Purposes Benefit (Sole Parent if youngest child is aged under 14) and the Widow's Benefit (if youngest child is aged under 14). Sole Parent Support is available to sole parents caring for children under the age of 14 who are available for or are ready to prepare for part-time work.

- **Supported Living Payment** – Replaced the Invalid’s Benefit and Domestic Purposes Benefit (Caring for Sick or Infirm). The Supported Living Payment is available to people who are severely restricted or unable to work on a long-term basis because of a health condition or disability and for people who are caring for someone who needs significant care.

Some types of assistance have been disestablished or have been renamed. These are also included for your reference.

- Table One shows the number of working age clients receiving a main benefit as at 30 June for the years 1990 to 2013 broken down by year, benefit group, ethnicity group and gender.
- Table Two shows the number of clients in receipt of a main benefit as at 30 June for the years 2014 to 2018 broken down by year, benefit group, ethnicity group and gender.
- Table Three shows the number of clients receiving pensions as at 30 June for the years 1998 to 2018, broken down by year, ethnicity group and gender.

In addition, please note the ethnicity classification that is used to construct this table does not necessarily align with the current Statistics New Zealand classification of ethnicity. Ethnicity details recorded by the Ministry have been gathered under a varied of classification methods as clients come into contact with the Ministry.

Please note that the Ministry’s current statistical system only holds complete benefit history for people who received a benefit since mid 1996. The ethnic group information has only been collected and reported since 1998. Prior to 1996 information requested was not reported on. Some benefit statistics for earlier periods are in the Statistical reports on the Ministry’s website, but not by ethnicity and gender.

The principles and purposes of the Official Information Act 1982 under which you made your request are:

- to create greater openness and transparency about the plans, work and activities of the Government,
- to increase the ability of the public to participate in the making and administration of our laws and policies and
- to lead to greater accountability in the conduct of public affairs.

This Ministry fully supports those principles and purposes. The Ministry therefore intends to make the information contained in this letter and any attached documents available to the wider public shortly. The Ministry will do this by publishing this letter on the Ministry of Social Development's website. Your personal details will be deleted and the Ministry will not publish any information that would identify you as the person who requested the information.
