Hi Mark

I spoke with [REDACTED] of 26 Isis Street on site today.

There is water seeping from the footpath directly outside the steps into his property, and also weeping from the carriageway just below the intersection of Wye Street and Isis Street. He has had a plumber investigate, and that plumber does not believe it is coming from the water supply or sewerage reticulation. I agree with this assessment, and believe it is simply ground water finding the path of least resistance following rain.

There are mudtanks on the intersection of Wye and Isis, which discharge to the SIMTR corridor. [REDACTED] thinks the two issues may be related, and I agreed that they may be, or if not directly related then certainly the same sort of phenomenon. As far as I can ascertain they are ground water issues affecting a carriageway and a footpath, and therefore a Roothing matter.
