I refer to your email of 23 June 2019, requesting information from the New Zealand Parole Board under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA).

You have asked the following;

In regards to inmates that have been sentenced to a life sentence with a non parole period, under what grounds can that inmate apply for an early parole application/board etc? Or early release?

Are there any special grounds under good behaviour conditions that inmates can apply for early parole application etc?

Sections 26 and 84(3) of the Parole Act 2002 ("the Act") are relevant to offenders serving a life sentence seeking to apply for early consideration of parole.
