## Official Information Act 1982 request

Thank you for your Official Information Act 1982 (OIA) request of 25 July 2019 about information relating to court appointed interpreters. Specifically, you requested:

- 1. The number of court appointed interpreters in Auckland and Wellington courts.
- 2. The number of interpreters that have been appointed for the Immigration and Protection Tribunal.
- 3. The names of those interpreters.

On 9 August 2019, your request was clarified by the Ministry of Justice (the Ministry):

- To include all courts in the wider Auckland and Wellington regions (Auckland/South Auckland/ Manukau, and Wellington/Porirua/The Hutt Valley); and
- to include the number of events that had an interpreter.

Before I respond to your request, I would like to apologise for the delay. You should note that interpreters used by the District and High Court of New Zealand are appointed by a Deputy Registrar of the District Court, usually a Service Manager or Court Registry Officer. However, interpreters aren't provided with any certification or identification by the Ministry, and they are not technically employed by the Ministry.

In response to questions 1 and 2 of your request, please see the attached tables. Table 1 counts the number of available interpreter providers. Table 2 counts the number of events that had an interpreter present.

The information you have requested in question 3 is withheld under section 9(2)(a) of the OIA to protect the privacy of natural persons.
