Thank you for your visit last Friday when you raised concerns with me about an event advertised in NZ Chinese media, to which the Chinese government had taken exception and wanted stopped.

As I explained at the time, the event was not a University one, but was apparently, according to the advertisement, to be held in one of our buildings. Investigation revealed that the rooms had not been booked correctly or paid for by the group organising the advertised event. Moreover, it was to be held on a day when the building in question was to be closed for a public holiday.

Happily, on this instance your concerns and ours coincided, and the event did not proceed at the University. I understand one of my staff informed you of this by email on Friday afternoon.

Nevertheless, I would like to take this opportunity to re-affirm that not only in the University, where academic freedom is taken very seriously, but also in New Zealand at large, freedom of speech and assembly are held as core democratic principles and fundamental values for our society. In all matters within New Zealand's jurisdiction these freedoms must continue to be amongst our primary considerations as a public institution.

I am sure that you can understand our position, and that the University has no wish to deliberately offend the government and people of China.

Once again thank you for raising your concerns with me in person. I share the hope you expressed at the end of our conversation that we might meet again soon for more positive discussions.
