Thank you for your email of 2 September 2013 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982:

• Can you inform me as to how many exemptions have been granted to individuals whose eyesight does not meet the requirements of the law.

An amendment to Clause 38(2)(a)(i) of the Land Transport (Driver Licensing) Rule 1999 made in October 2011 has potentially seen a reduction in the number of exemptions issued, as in some instances an exemption would no longer be required. The Rule can be found online at:
