Are there any more out there? Also, are there any Ministerial Advisory Group set up in relation to Immigration New Zealand or Regional economic development?

On 8 October 2019 we confirmed "Ministerial Advisory Groups" to include high profile public reviews initiated by Ministers, advisory groups which have significant associated work programmes, and MBIE-led reviews with significant work programmes.

After consultation across the MBIE business units, please find the attached Annex in response to point one of your request. This information relates to the 2018/19 financial year.

With regard to your second point, the Provincial Development Unit (established to support the delivery of regionally focused initiatives in promotion of regional economic development) does not lead Ministerial Advisory Groups.

I note that you have previously received a list of Immigration New Zealand departmental groups, where members of the public and/or non-government stakeholders give MBIE advice on immigration issues. You can find the immigration advisory/review groups active in the 2018/19 financial year in the annex provided, which refers to groups with associated significant work programmes.

The information provided in this response is intended for inclusion in the MBIE 2018/2019 Annual Review, due to be published on Parliament's website in the first quarter of 2020. The full review document will include further information you may find helpful, such as estimated costs, key dates and head count figures relating to review, inquiry and working groups.
