Dear Mr Straub

Thank you for your email on 5 October 2019 to the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment (MBIE) requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA), the following information:

"In the event that it is NZ that makes first contact with an extra terrestrial intelligence, what are the protocols for that interaction?"

We are refusing your request under section 18(g) of the OIA because the information you have requested does not exist. The New Zealand Space Agency has no policies or protocols regarding the event of first contact with extra-terrestrial intelligent life.

I would like to refer you to the Cabinet paper and Cabinet Minutes from April 2016 titled "The Scope of Space Policy and a Lead Space Agency", available on the MBIE website <a href="https://www.mbie.govt.nz/science-and-technology/space/our-regulatory-regime">https://www.mbie.govt.nz/science-and-technology/space/our-regulatory-regime</a>, which outlines the scope and functions of the Space Agency.
