Dear Mr Tipton

Thank you for your email of 10 October 2019 to the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment requesting, under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act), the following information:

I refer to the draft findings of MBIE's current Retail Fuel Market Study, released on 20 August 2019. Appendix F of the draft findings describes in some detail the data that MBIE received from the various supplies of fuel in New Zealand. Specifically, paragraphs F23 through F43 describe a final data set that (among other items) contains, for each day [during the study period] and for each site, the quantity (in litres) of each type of fuel that was sold. The data has also been augmented by assigning a geographic region to each site.

Can you please supply me with the daily sales data, aggregated by geographic region?

This letter is to advise you that your request has been transferred to the Commerce Commission.

This is because the information you have requested is not held by the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment. Section 14(b)(i) of the Act allows me to transfer any request where the information is not held, but is believed to be held by another department, organisation or Minister of the Crown.
