Thank you for your request of 16 October 2019 to Oranga Tamariki—Ministry for Children (Oranga Tamariki), requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

- *Is it mandatory to inform the candidate about the result after the job interviews for social workers conducted by the ministry of children?*
- *If yes, what is the timeframe to do so?*

When an individual applies for a job with Oranga Tamariki, we aim to respond with the result of their application in a timely fashion. You have asked about our timeframe in relation to notifying a candidate about the result of a job interview. The timeframe can often vary; however, it is reasonable to expect a phone call from the hiring manager within two weeks of completing the interview. If the individual applies for a job, but is not selected for the interview process, they can expect a notification by email confirming their application has been unsuccessful within two weeks of the job listing closing.

Oranga Tamariki intends to make the information contained in this letter available to the wider public shortly. We will do this by publishing this letter on our website. Your personal details will be deleted and we will not publish any information that would identify you as the person who requested the information.
