Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987
Re: CAS-101232-W0G2F1

I refer to your email dated 6 October 2013, which we received the same day, requesting information relating to the relocation of speed limit signs on Point Wells Road.

The cost of the physical works for the gate way treatment which included traffic control, installation of red surfacing, traversable traffic islands, signage and associated work is \$29,946.95. In terms of Section 7(2)(b)(11) Auckland Transport is withholding information relating to the individual costs for each of these items as this information is commercially sensitive.

Consultation was carried out by post with the Residents and Rate Payers Association, The Rodney Local Board, New Zealand Police, Automobile Association (AA), Road Transport Forum New Zealand and Heavy Haulage Association. The adjoining property owners were also advised by post of the installation of the new treatment.

A report on the speed limit change was approved by Auckland Transport on 14 June 2013. This report was not externally distributed or publicised but can be provided if requested.

You have the right in accordance with section 27(3) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987 (LGOIMA) to make a complaint to the Office of the Ombudsmen if you are not satisfied with our response.
