Thank you for your email of 19 December 2019 requesting under the Official Information Act 1982 (the OIA), the following information:

- 1. Requesting List of questions (Questionnaire) case officer from Immigration New Zealand ask/request applicant while assessing SMC Resident Visa application?
- 2. Requesting List of questions (Questionnaire) case officer from Immigration New Zealand ask/request applicant's employer while assessing SMC Resident Visa application?
- 3. Requesting List of questions (Questionnaire) case officer from Immigration New Zealand ask during interview with applicant's employer while assessing SMC Resident Visa application?
- 4. Requesting List of questions (Questionnaire) case officer from Immigration New Zealand ask during interview with applicant while assessing SMC Resident Visa application?

I am writing to advise you that the Ministry will provide a response but needs to extend the time available to answer your request. The Ministry's response will be with you no later than 2 March 2020. The reason for the extension relies on s15A(1)(b) of the OIA - consultations necessary to make a decision on the request are such that a proper response to the request cannot be made within the original time limit.
