Official Information Act Request

Thank you for your information requests of 29 October 2019, to the Minister for Whānau Ora and to Te Puni Kōkiri, requesting information regarding The Whānau Ora Commissioning Agency. The Minister transferred your request to Te Puni Kōkiri for a direct response.

You have asked:

• please provide me with the following information on funding amounts to the Whanau Ora Commissioning Agency."

Total public funding awarded in 2017, 2018, 2019

Annual salary to the CEO 2017-2019

Annual salary to the commissioning agency management team members 2017-2019

Annual payment/honorarium/salary to the Chair of the board and individual board members 2017-2019

And

answer the following questions:
 How much public money in total did the whanau ora commissioning agency receive in 2019, 2018, 2017.
 For each of those years,
 How much are the two patrons paid yearly
 How much were board members paid yearly, including the chair
 How much is the management team including the CEO paid yearly



Your requests have been considered in accordance with the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

The total amount of funding provided by Te Puni Kōkiri to the Whānau Ora Commissioning Agency over the past three financial years is as follows:
