 5. *The number of complaints investigated by IPCA that concluded serious misconduct*

In relation to requests 2 through to 5 this is refused under section 18 (f) OIA, as the information requested cannot be made available without substantial collation or research.

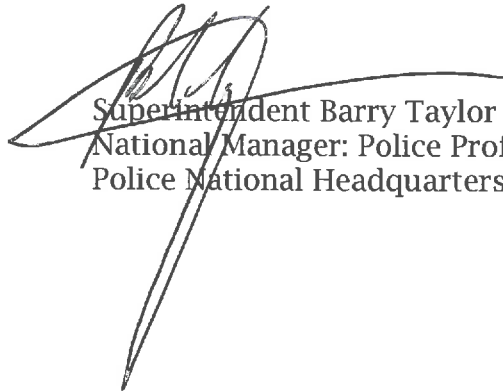
