Thank you for your request of 14 January 2020, under the Official Information Act 1982, for the following information:


Please provide information on the changes made to marking schedules after the exam date for AS91261, AS92162, and AS92167.

As per the email conversation between yourself and Steve Bargh, Acting Manager Secondary Examinations, we are unable to provide the requested information until 1 April 2020. This is to ensure fairness and avoid interference for the process of reviewing and reconsidering students' examination scripts for NCEA and New Zealand Scholarship. I understand you are comfortable with this deferment.

We suggest you withdraw your request and resubmit it on 6 March. This would make 3 April the due date for the information to be sent to you.
