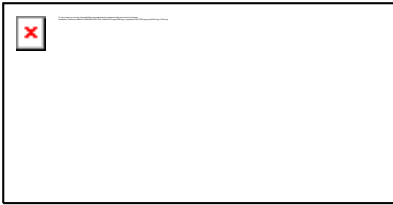

Following our meeting, we've certainly got a few action items to cover off internally. In particular, we'll be turning our minds in more detail to:

- a. Establishing the nature and extent of the Public Risk / Operational Risk associated with the Dataset.
- b. Considering the appropriate CC licences and terms on which the Dataset could be shared.
- c. Considering the technological infrastructure for the sharing of the Dataset in real-time via API.
- d. Developing appropriate wrap-around comms to mitigate the Public / Operational risk, the 'moral hazard' and ensure that licensees (viewers) understand the provenance, purpose, nature, and extent of the data.

From memory, there were a few documents / link that you were also going to send for us to review. When you have the chance, can you please fire those through?

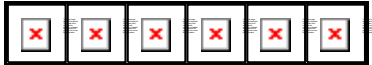

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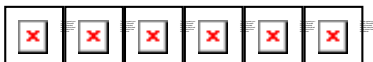
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
