**Extension of timeframe in order to respond to your request for official information for feedback received on the draft District Plan**

I refer to your request for official information relating to feedback received on the draft District Plan post 5 September 2019. We are processing your request under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act (LGOIMA) 1987.

This letter is to advise that we have extended the time limit to respond to your request to 27 March 2019 under section 14 (1) (a) of LGOIMA. This is due to the request containing a large quantity of information and meeting the original time limit would unreasonably interfere with the operations of the local authority.

You have the right under section 27(3) of LGOIMA to make a complaint to the Ombudsman about this timeframe extension.
