Dear Beth,

I refer to your request received by the Ministry on 18 February 2020 requesting the following information from Immigration New Zealand ("INZ"):

- *Could you please provide a table of the following information*
 - 1) *From 1 January 2019 - Present could you please provide information as to how many Residents have been made liable under the following provisions of the Immigration Act Section 155 - 156 - 157 - 158 - 159 - 160 - 161 - 162 - 163*
If possible could it please be separated for each specific part of the Act
 - 2) *From 1 January 2019 - Present could you indicate how many Residents have actually been deported from New Zealand and if available, which provision made them liable in the first place*

This letter is to notify you that the Ministry is extending the time available to it to answer your request. The Ministry's response will now be made by 16 April 2020.

The reason for the extension is:

Section 15A(1)(b): consultations necessary to make a decision on the request are such that a proper response to the request cannot reasonably be made within the original time limit.
