Official information request for statistics associated with subdivision consents and related matters issued by Ashburton (CRM0800094/20)

I refer to your official information request dated 3 March 2020 for statistics for the last 6 and 12 months (1 October 2019 - 29 February 2020 & 1 March 2019 - 29 February 2020) and specifically:

- Number of Subdivision Consents
- •Average processing time (mean and median) for non-notified consents (working days, excluding on-hold days)
- •Average processing time (mean and median) for non-notified consents (working days, including on-hold days)
- •Number of 223 application requests
- •Average processing times (mean & median) (working days) 224c applications
- •Number of 224c application requests
- Average processing times (mean & median) (working days)

Much of the information you have requested is harvested as part of our standard recording and reporting functions. This information is attached as **appendix 1** to this letter.

The request for the remaining information (highlighted in yellow within appendix 1) is captured in course form within our systems but would require specific reports to be created to harvest the data you have requested, the costs of this work would be recovered in accordance with the Council's set charge of \$41 per half hour after the first hour.

Our Information Services Team estimate the time needed to create, test and produce the required reports is between 8 and 16 hours. This is estimated to be similar or less than the time required to interrogate and extract information manually.

In order to proceed with the remainder of the request and pursuant to section 13(4) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act (1987) we would require the advance payment of \$574.00 along with confirmation of your agreement to pay additional costs for production of the work if required. Please note, we have not charged for the work associated with your request to date.

Once these matters have been addressed, Council staff would include the work within existing work streams. I am advised that this would be in approximately 2-4 weeks from the time of confirmation.
