**Official Information Act 1982 request**

Thank you for your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA) of 19 March 2020 to the Ministry of Justice (the Ministry) regarding legally aided litigants orders in the Family Court.

Specifically, you have requested the total number of legally aided litigants in the family court, also the non-legally aided litigants from the year 2010 to 2019.

The Ministry of Justice is responding and re-directing resources as needed, to assist with the government's response to COVID-19. This is impacting our ability to deliver some of our usual functions within the normal timeframes. In the current climate it is not possible to provide you with a definitive date by which we will be able to respond to your request. However, please be assured that we will keep you updated and will provide you with a new expected due date as soon as we are in a position to do so. We are grateful for your patience and understanding in these unprecedented times.

The OIA requires that we advise you of our decision on your request no later than 20 working days after the day we received your request. As mentioned above, it will not be possible to meet that time limit. Therefore, we are writing to notify you of an extension of the time to make our decision, to within 30 working days of the office re-opening.
