Dear Ms Anne

Thank you for your email of 23 April 2020, requesting information about people convicted for child exploitation. Your request has been considered under the Official Information Act 1982 (OIA).

You have requested:

- 1) *The number of people who have been convicted for child exploitation and the selling of a child's body, between the years 2010 - 2020, and the length of sentence they remained in prison for.*
- 2) *How are prisoners reintegrated into society safely after committing/ being involved with child exploitation, and how is it ensured this cannot be done again?*

Corrections requires clarification in order to process your request for information.

It appears your request may be referring to offences specifically related to “dealing in slaves” and “receiving earnings from an underage person”. This would include the following kinds of offences:

1231	DEALING IN SLAVE PERSONS UNDER 18
2973	ASSIST UNDER 18 YO TO PROVIDE SEXUAL SERVICES
2974	RECEIVE EARNINGS FROM UNDER 18 YO

Alternatively, please advise if you are seeking information regarding total convictions for all offences involving any form of sexual assault or abuse against children.
