





I agree with Jennie that this is tight to organise prior to Christmas and there are other things on in the next few weeks that will contend for organisation. I had a look at the 9(2)(b)(ii) and I share Jennie's view that the brief needs to get out widely. Even then I expect this project and

briefings to attract only a small number of firms and I wonder whether it would be more effective to reduce to two: Auckland and Wellington. I think the complexity of the project and requirements will suit a small group meeting approach.

Dec 16-18 makes sense as it ought to be clear of other distractions by that stage. Unfortunately our NZTE Auckland meeting rooms will be out of action by that stage as we have a refurbishment. However, we may be able to use the S6(d), S9(2)(b)(ii) – if Jennie can confirm its availability? I expect we will be ok for rooms at NZTE Wellington that week.

There is little knowledge in New Zealand about \$\frac{59(2)(b)(0)}{2}, and relatively poor awareness of the wider Australian defence programme – the opportunities and its requirements.
