Dear Huda,

We refer to your Official Information Act request of 21 June 2020 regarding information for general entry to the medical (MB ChB) programme at University of Otago for the last six years (2015 - 2020).

Further to our letters to you of 31 July 2020 and 22 October 2020 in relation to some of the information you requested, we now set out below our response on the remainder of your information request.

To repeat what was stated in our letters of 31 July 2020 and 22 October 2020, data prior to 2017 is not held centrally in our Student Management System. To obtain the information you seek for 2015 and 2016 would require substantial collation and staff time, and is therefore declined pursuant to section 18(f) of the Official Information Act.

The data we have provided below relates to both domestic and international applicants.
