Dear Mr Harris

I refer to your Official Information Act request of 20 November 2013. You asked whether the Police have complied with the Deputy Auditors-General's recommendation from the Commission of Inquiry into Police Conduct, and if so on what date. This was with regard to the establishment of an early warning system.

I apologise for the delay in replying to you.

The Police Early Intervention (EI) system was implemented in December 2012 to give effect to recommendations 47 and 48. EI includes:

- An EI policy specifying roles, responsibilities and processes (giving effect to recommendation 47)
- An EI database (giving effect to the first part of recommendation 48)
- An EI Manager and EI Analyst based at Police National Headquarters, and a network of EI lead employees within Police districts (giving effect to recommendation 47).

A system of monthly and annual reporting is currently being developed. At this time Police have not implemented the reporting of EI information into its promotion process.
