I refer to your request received 19 July 2020 in which you requested the following information:

 Emergency lighting parts/models, the part/model numbers as well as the manufacturer of said parts/models for Police Motorway patrol vehicles ranging from the year 2013 to the year 2018.

Please be aware that during the timeframe requested, we had two different companies who completed the fitting of emergency lighting for our vehicles. Nautech Electronics Ltd were our fit-out agent of choice until 2015 at which time the role of fit-out agent was taken over by Wade Group (2011) Ltd.

The following emergency light was fitted to our Motorway patrol vehicles by Nautech Electronics Ltd for the time period 2013 to October 2015:
