## Official Information Act request for copies of communications between the Prime Minister and Bill Gates

Thank you for your Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) request, received on 1 August 2020. You requested (numbering added):

- 1. all correspondence, meetings, phone conversations, memos, payments etc between you and Bill Gates (and his agents).
- 2. And also, between all branches of your government, and Bill Gates (and his agents) between 1/8/2019 and 1/8/2020."

In relation to the first part of your request, please find attached a letter from Bill and Melinda Gates that was received by the Prime Minister, Rt Hon Jacinda Ardern, on 26 April 2018. I note that the Prime Minister did not attend the Goalkeepers 2018 event, however, she did attend the next year during her visit to New York in September 2019. Additionally, the Prime Minister had a phone call with Melinda Gates as the Co-Chair of the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation on 17 June 2020. No minutes of the call were taken. Also identified were some administrative emails between the Office of the Prime Minister and staff members of the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation which have been deemed out of scope.

In relation to the second part of your request, that information is not held by this office. However, I believe this information is more closely connected to the function of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade (MFAT). Accordingly, I have decided under section 14(b)(ii) of the Act to transfer your request to the MFAT. I note that although MFAT is the agency most likely to hold information, neither MFAT or the Prime Minister's Office will be providing correspondence between all Government Departments and Bill Gates. As this will require substantial collation and research and involve an unreasonable amount of consultation.

MFAT has 20 working days from receipt of this transfer to make a decision on your request.

You have the right to ask the Ombudsman to investigate and review my decision under section 28(3) of the Act.
