Your Official Information Act request OIA2021-0189, dated 11 September 2020

Thank you for your Official Information Act (the Act) request, which was transferred to the Department of Internal Affairs (the Department).

You have requested:

 Please also provide me with any information held (reports, briefings, aide memoire) held by the ministry in relation to any Covid-related proposals or ideas promoted by Mr Morgan or his associates.

We have interpreted your request as reports, briefings and aide memoires prepared by the Department in relation to the Bluetooth-enabled contact tracing, that have not already been proactively released.

The Department has identified the documents in **Appendix A** as those that fall within the scope of your request.

Please note that some information in the documents has been withheld under the following sections of the Act:

- 6(a) to maintain the security or defence of New Zealand
- 6(b)(i) to maintain confidence of information provided by the Government or agency of another country
- 9(2)(a) protect the privacy of natural persons
- 9(2)(f)(ii) maintain collective and individual Ministerial responsibility
- 9(2)(f)(iv) protect, for the time being, the confidentiality of advice tendered by officials
- 9(2)(g)(i) free and frank expression of opinions
- 9(2)(j) to enable a Minister of the Crown or any department or organisation holding the information to carry out negotiations
- 9(2)(k) to prevent the disclosure or use of the information for improper gain or advantage

In addition, you may be aware that the Government and the Department have released advice, Cabinet papers and independent reports related to the Bluetooth-enabled contact tracing card. These are available at:
