Tēnā koe Ryan,

Thank you for your email of 16 September 2020 to the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment (MBIE) requesting under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) the following information:

"I would like a copy of the application submitted by Glenbrook Vintage Railway for the STAPP funding."

MBIE has identified one document within the scope of your request which is detailed in the document schedule. Some information within this document has been redacted or withheld under the following sections of the Act:

9(2)(a) to protect the privacy of natural persons, including that of deceased natural persons.

9(2)(b)(ii) to protect information where the making available of the information would be likely unreasonably to prejudice the commercial position of the person who supplied or who is the subject of the information.

In terms of section 9(1) of the Act, I am satisfied that, in the circumstances, the withholding of this information is not outweighed by other considerations that render it desirable to make the information available in the public interest.

I trust you find the information helpful. You have the right to seek an investigation and review by the Ombudsman of my decision to withhold information relating to this request, in accordance with section 28(3) of the Act.
