APPLICATION TO USE PART COUNCIL RESERVE BUCKLANDS BEACH ROAD

Further to a site meeting earlier this year with Mr Webster I wish to confirm the arrangement discussed at that time regarding the construction of a boundary fence on your northern boundary adjoining Council reserve.

Manukau City Council is prepared to allow the construction of the above mentioned fence a maximum of 3m from the boundary line within the adjoining reserve for a maximum length of 16m (see attached plan) subject to the following conditions:

- An accessway is to be constructed in the fence, minimum of 2.5m wide at a position determined by Council.
- b) Council is to have the right of access along the driveway to your property during normal working hours.
- c) No private vehicles/trailers/boats etc are to be driven on or stored on the adjoining reserve.
- d) Either party may terminate this agreement by four months notice in writing.



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

Your urgency in this matter would be appreciated.


