is 40. Can you confirm that this value (40) is used in processing ALL tests done in New Zealand?

Could you explain why such a high value is being used?"

I can confirm that PCR assays for all COVID-19 tests run for 40 cycles in IANZ accredited New Zealand laboratories. This is stipulated by the manufacturer instructions who have performed extensive validation and verification of their assays.
