Summary

- No individuals mobilised to terrorist violence in New Zealand in the June –August 2019 reporting period. New Zealand-based extremists remain under counterterrorism investigation.
- Extreme right, white nationalist and racial agitation continued over the reporting period, especially online. However, some individuals and groups appear to be disengaging from such rhetoric, possibly to avoid attention from authorities.
- Known Islamist extremists in New Zealand are in general disorganised, unmotivated, and uncoordinated. Meanwhile, some New Zealand citizens remain in Syria after travelling there to join terrorist groups active in the Syrian conflict.
- Lone actor terrorist acts remain possible in the current environment, and individuals with extremist views may resort to violence due to personal grievances and feelings of disempowerment rather than to deliberately advance any ideological cause.
