**Response to official information request for information on the Water Leak in Onepoto**

I refer to your request for official information received 23 February 2021 asking when the Council will permanently fix the repeated leaks in the water main within the accessway adjacent to the boatsheds at Onepoto. We have processed your request under the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act (LGOIMA) 1987.

The information you requested is enclosed. The question you specified is included as a numbered heading in bold below, with our response following.

- 1. When will the leaks in the watermain within the access strip along the Onepoto foreshore and in front of the boatsheds there be repaired?**

The Council has had two requests related to watermain leaks in this location. The first (service request no. CWS1808/20) was for two leaks at 44 Onepoto Rd. The repairs were completed, and reinstatement was made on 26 February 2021.

A second request reporting a water leak (service request no. CWS0199/21) was completed by repairing a pinhole leak in a galvanised iron rider main on 21 February 2021 and the reinstatement was made on March 2021.
