Response to your request for official information

Thank you for your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) to the Ministry of Health (the Ministry) on 7 March 2021 for:

"...any documents or correspondence regarding quidelines for sexual activity at any of the different alert levels during the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020."

The Ministry has not produced any information within scope of your request. Your request is therefore refused under section 18(g)(i) of the Act, as the information is not held by the Ministry.
