Response to your request for official information

Thank you for your request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) to the Ministry of Health (the Ministry) on 3 April 2021 for:

"The Cominarty vaccine is being rolled out to far more than "a limited number of patients" and there appears to be no restriction in doing so.

The Ministry of Health and other members of the Government (including the Prime Minister) are constantly reassuring the public that the vaccine is "safe and effective".

It would appear that on both counts, the Ministry is in breach of the Medicines Act.

Could you please explain by what authority the Ministry is able to do this?"

The data sheet includes: "COMIRNATY has provisional consent (see section 5.1) for the indication: Active immunisation to prevent coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) caused by SARS-CoV-2, in individuals 16 years of age and older. The use of this vaccine should be in accordance with official recommendations.
