Hi Owen,

Thanks for your email.

First, a status update on where this one is at: I have gathered together the information that will fall in scope of Harold's request and provided redactions (I have sent this for internal consultation – following that it will receive external consultation). Contrary to the draft reply, the request **does** contain a formal analysis of the report (in the form of a ministerial submission). The technical analysis contained within this submission was informed by MPI and MOH, however the submission did come from MFAT and is addressed to MFA. Therefore I don't think we can say "The Ministry has completed no formal analysis of this report" or "While nor formal analysis is contained".

The key reason why it will need to take until at least 14 July to provide the information to Harold, is that there are a number of OIAs on the same topic (Out of scope is very wide in scope and includes every document also in the Harold one) and there was insufficient resourcing to do the necessary work before the original deadline (hence the need for an extension). The OIA's on the origins topic also require a number of parties to review redactions (AMER / NAD / MOH / MPI) as all have equities in the topic s9(2)(g)(i)

Regarding early release of some information, the submission I refer to above that contains analysis, has also been requested by ^{s9(2)(a)} We have handed this back to ESD, so am not sure about where that is, but this is the pivotal document of analysis and if it has been given to Sam, would it also be able to be given to Harold?
