## Partial transfer of your request for official information

Thank you for your follow up request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) on 26 July 2021 regarding stress tests (H202106270):

- "1. An April stress test relating to trans-Tasman quarantine-free travel. This is referred to on page 48 of this document: "Further testing and scenario planning also took place in April 2021, pending the introduction of guarantine free travel with Australia."
- 2. A "scenario planning workshop" relating to pre-departure testing conducted in January.
- Another workshop related to Cook Islands quarantine-free travel conducted in May."

We note that the documents you refer to in parts 2 and 3 of your request are documents published by the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet (DPMC) as seen here: https://covid19.govt.nz/assets/reports/Independent-Advisory-Groups/IAG5-COVID-19-Systemresponse-to-recommendations-from-the-review-report-into-the-February-2021-Auckland-Outbreak.pdf.
