Response to your official information request

Further to your letter of 15 June 2021 and our subsequent correspondence on 13 July 2021 and 30 July 2021 updating you on our position in respect of your query.

We have now received the 2021 Asbestos Management Plan for 155 The Terrace and having reviewed its contents we are happy to release the document along with the other information highlighted in my previous letter to you. To this end, please find attached

- Asbestos Management Plan for RNZ House, 155 The Terrace. (Dated November 2019)
- Air Monitoring Test Results (June 2021)
- Asbestos Management Plan (July 2021)

You will note from the Asbestos Management Plans, that asbestos containing materials have been found to be present and/or are suspected to be present within the buildings. These materials are generally located in areas not accessible to our staff and because of their undisturbed nature do not present an immediate risk to the occupants and users of the building.

Toitū Te Whenua Land Information New Zealand continues to work closely with our landlords and their representatives to manage any potential risk from these materials. Any works in the building that may disturb or disrupt areas containing asbestos will be done in accordance with best practice safety protocols, as outlined in the plan.
