As you can see, they are now almost fully our dark blue/grey Metlink colour, with some, limited other brighter Metlink colours to help people know where to tag on and tag off. Just to note that the top of the validators are the same dark blue/grey that you see on most parts of the validators (an earlier version had the tops our lime green Metlink colour – this is no longer the case). This latest design has significantly benefited from the workshops we have held with the accessibility communities who have indicated their strong preference for the way in which we have now sought to portray the validators.




