5. The total number of 3Fs, for days of the week Thursday, Friday, and Saturday, by month, for the years 2000 - 2013,
 - a) For the Auckland City Central Area

In the instance the specific date range for any of these categories is not available a representative selection of years would be an alternative.

The purpose of this letter is to notify you that Police require an extension of time in which to respond to your request, pursuant to section 15A(1) of the Official Information Act 1982, because the request necessitates a search through a large quantity of information and consultations such that a proper response to the request cannot reasonably be made within the original time limit. Police require until 13 June 2014 to provide a substantive response to your request.

You have the right to complain to the Office of the Ombudsmen about this extension.
