**Request made under the Official Information Act 1982**

Thank you for your 8 September 2021 requesting further information about public transport definitions in the One Network Framework. Your email has been treated as a request under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).

Waka Kotahi is extending the 20 working days available to respond to your request, as allowed for under section 15A of the Act. We require an additional 5 working days to respond to your request and will send you a response on or before 13 October 2021.

The deadline is being extended because the external consultations necessary to make a decision on your request are such that a thorough response cannot reasonably be made within the original 20-working-day limit.
