Official information request for a summary of consents at 51 Seaview Road.

I refer to your official information request dated 16 September 2021 for a summary of consents at 51 Seaview Road and also those associated with a building that is located on the coastal area directly in front of No. 51 Seaview Road.

I acknowledge that after discussions with Leonie McPhail (Manager Building Assurance), that the scope of your initial request was reduced to consents relating to the building located in the coastal area in front of No. 51 Seaview Road only.

Following a review of our records we can confirm that the Council does not hold any consents for this building. On that basis, the information has been refused under Section 17(e) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act on the grounds that the information does not exist.
