Please find attached the pdf plans of the SH30/SH33 Te Ngae Junction Feasibility Options that we discussed on Thursday 6 May 2021.

To summarise:

- 1. Option 1 new four arm roundabout, closure of Rangiteaorere Rd at intersection with SH30.
- 2. Option 2 new three arm roundabout with new right turn bay provided at Rangiteaorere Rd intersection with SH30.
- 3. Option 3 new three arm roundabout with no proposed changes at Rangiteaorere Rd.
- 4. Combined Pdf with all 3 Options presented.

Option 1 is the Waka Kotahi (NZTA) 'favoured option' as it provides the greatest safety benefits for road users and the local community but does not preclude the future development proposals of Ngati Rangiteaorere.

After much discussion on the options presented, you provided verbal support for Waka Kotahi to proceed with the development of Opt on 1 a new four-arm roundabout and the closure of Rangiteaorere Road.
