Terms of Reference: Operational Steering Group

Purpose of the Operational Steering Group:

- Ensure compliance activity is appropriately focused based on current situation and CCI-derived insights.
- Use CCI-derived insights to drive strategic communications.
- Discuss key operational achievements, including progress on key deliverables and projects.
- · Discuss operational matters related to IT, resource, healthy and safety etc.
- Raise operational risks and issues for attention and allocate actions to resolve, or escalate to Compliance Governance.
- Identify and resolve operational barriers to establishing and implementing the compliance operating model.

Role of the Operational Steering Group:

• The group is responsible for ensuring that compliance deployment reflects the national situation based on the information which they are receiving, and ensuring that the function is operating effectively.

Operational Steering Group responsibilities:

- Represent the perspectives of their respective organisations.
- Bring subject matter expertise based on organisational and functional accountability/powers.
- Raise risks and issues related to their respective organisation or that span across agencies.
- Ensure that relevant inputs are provided to the CCI.
- Analyse how CCI insights impact their respective organisation and across agencies.

Governance Process:

- The group will meet twice weekly. Out-of-session meetings can be scheduled if necessary.
- **Inputs:** Deployment priorities; Compliance themes and insights; Risk-based tasking; Compliance outcomes.
- **Outputs:** Deployment planning; Set priorities; Risk areas identified with mitigations; Allocated actions; Strategic communications; Decision papers to governance; Escalation of risks and issues to governance.
