Your request has been considered under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act).


Extension of Time Limit – Section 15A(1)(a), Official Information Act 1982

As your request is for a large quantity of official information or necessitates a search through a large quantity of information, meeting the original time limit of 20 working days from the date your request was received would unreasonably interfere with the operations of the Ministry.

I am extending the time limit for replying to you to 8 August 2014 in accordance with section 15A(1)(a) of the Act. I consider that this is a reasonable period of time in the circumstances detailed above.

Under sections 19 and 28(3) of the Official Information Act 1982 you have the right to ask an Ombudsman to review this decision.
