Your requests have been refused pursuant to the following provisions of the OIA:

- Section 9(2)(a) to protect the privacy of individual persons.
- Section 9(2)(ba) to protect information subject to an obligation of confidentially where the making available of the information would be likely to prejudice the supply of similar information.
- Section 9(2)(g) to maintain the effective conduct of public affairs through the free and frank expression of opinions by or between members of the Police in the course of their duty.
- Section 9(2)(h) to maintain legal professional privilege.

You have the right, under section 28(3) of the OIA to ask the Ombudsman to review my decision if you are not satisfied with the way I have responded to your request.
