Subject: Service Delivery Parking Compliance Covid -19 Level 3 Revised Plan, 15 October 2021

Teams,

Attached is the revised operating plan for Parking Compliance, confirmed by [REDACTED] today.
As of 00.01 Friday 15th October 2021 we will commence live enforcement across the Infringement categories.

We have taken the Govt's ruling on registration temporary extensions verbatim.

Because of the recent 2021 COVID-19 lockdown, from 15 September 2021 temporary extensions are granted for several land transport documents that have or are due to expire. The extensions allow people to continue driving and using their vehicles legally while alert level restrictions prevent them from renewing the documents.

Temporary extensions will remain in place until 30 November 2021. More details are available below.

Many vehicle inspection providers and driver licensing agents are busy in the lead up to the summer holiday period so you are encouraged to renew your documents as soon as possible. This also ensures vehicles remains safe to drive and allows time for you to receive updated documents.

All vehicle licences (regos) must also be current by 30 November 2021.

Renew your vehicle licence (rego) now

Warrants of fitness/Certificates of fitness

Eligibility: Effective from 15 September 2021, temporary extensions are in place for WoFs/CoFs that expire during the period of 21 July 2021 to 30 November 2021

Renewal date: You must have your WoF/CoF renewed by 11.59pm, 30 November 2021.

That does mean that expiries prior to 21 July are not exempt..
