Thank you for your email of 2 December 2021 to Oranga Tamariki—Ministry for Children (Oranga Tamariki), requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

- *I make this urgent request to assist the people in understanding what a "designated premises" is for the purposes of the COVID-19 Public Health Response (Protections Framework) Order 2021.*
 - *In accordance with the Protections Framework, a person seeking goods or services must not be refused access to the premises of health services that are partly or wholly funded by the Oranga Tamariki - Ministry for Children.*
- *Please urgently supply the following information under the Official Information Act 1982:*
 - *All premises that are partly or wholly funded by the Oranga Tamariki - Ministry for Children.*

The consultations necessary to make a decision on this request are such that a proper response cannot reasonably be made within the original time limit. For this reason, I am writing to extend the time limit for responding to your request until 31 January 2022, in accordance with section 15A(1)(b) of the Act. We will try to respond sooner than this date if possible.

If you are not satisfied with this decision, you have the right to ask an Ombudsman to review it.
